Did You Know?

Currently, 71% of students in the Early Learning Center at the Hanover YMCA are receiving some level of scholarship.

The Y is addressing youth obesity nationally and in the greater Hanover area with our new Rutters Room at the South Hanover Y. This room is dedicated to the physical and nutritional development of youth ages 7-13.

This past summer, our Y was able to provide a positive summer camp experience for 339 children in our community.

Our Y provides 1,061 seniors a place to become physically, mentally and spiritually healthy.

Our Y provides before and after school care for 279 students in six school districts in York and Adams counties.

We are striving to assist our neighbor agencies in their work, as well as furthering our work. In 2011, our Y had over 20 collaborations with local agencies in our community.

\$1,370 provides a child one year of pre-team gymnastics.

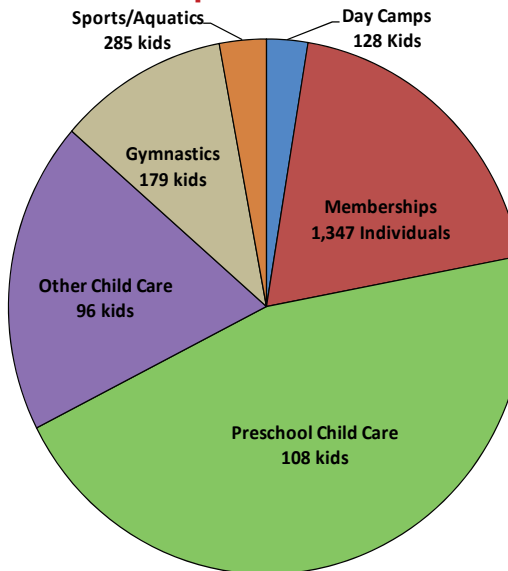
